## ARCHITECTURAL SHOWCASE

The Architectural Showcase at the 2017 Winter Conference held at The Hammock Beach Resort confirmed that award winning quality design is alive and well in the State of Florida. The projects submitted this year illustrated how good design can enhance the learning environments in our schools. These outstanding projects will contribute to their institution's academic success, and inspire our educational members to raise their design standards for future facilities.

There were 15 entries in 6 categories at the Winter Conference: Elementary Schools, Middle Schools, High Schools, Colleges, Universities, and Special Facilities. The entries were judged by three architects, who looked at seven criteria: 1) innovative response to the educational program; 2) aesthetics and use of materials; 3) flexibility for community use; 4) technology provisions; 5) sustainable design; 6) relationship of spaces and expandability; and 7) site development. This year Showcase entries could be submitted for projects that were still under construction as well as those that were completed and occupied.

The First Place recipients have been invited to present their designs in a Pecha Kucha format at a Thursday session of the 2017 Summer Conference July 10 – 13 at the Boca Raton Resort and Club in Boca Raton.
