FEFPA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2017-2018 ACADEMIC YEAR

Congratulations to this year's FEFPA Scholarship winners!

Thanks to our generous sponsors, we were able to provide two \$3,000 scholarships to two deserving students in Florida colleges and universities. The first scholarship winner is Rachel Chon, a junior at the University of Florida studying architecture and planning. The second scholarship winner is Nathalie Canate, a senior at the University of Florida studying architecture.

Each academic year FEFPA offers cash scholarship awards of \$3,000 to deserving Florida college students at the rate of \$1,500 per semester. Eligible applicants include sophomore through upper level undergraduate and graduate students who meet the eligibility requirements stated on the application instructions.
