FEFPA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2018-2019 ACADEMIC YEAR

Congratulations to this year's FEFPA Scholarship winners!

Thanks to our generous sponsors, we were able to provide two \$3,000 scholarships to two deserving students in Florida colleges and universities. The first scholarship winner is Sophia Neves, a sophomore at Florida International University studying architecture.
