FEFPA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2019-2020 ACADEMIC YEAR

Congratulations to this year's FEFPA Scholarship winners!

Thanks to our generous sponsors, we were able to provide two \$3,000 scholarships to two deserving students in Florida colleges and universities. The first scholarship winner is Antonio Miragaya, a graduate student at Florida International University studying architecture. The second scholarship winner is Michael Zang, a graduate student at Florida State University studying Urban Planning and Public Administration. Each academic year FEFPA offers cash scholarship awards of \$3,000 to deserving Florida college students at the rate of \$1,500 per semester.
