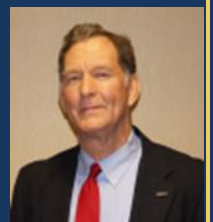

## FEFPA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

Congratulations to this year's FEFPA Scholarship winners!

Thanks to our generous sponsors, for the first time this year we increased our number of scholarships to three deserving students in Florida colleges and universities. The top ranked scholarship winner who was awarded \$3,000 is Antonio Miragaya, a graduate student at Florida International University studying architecture. The second ranked scholarship winner who will receive \$2,000 is Elena Passoni, a junior at Florida International University studying Architecture. The third ranked scholarship winner who will receive \$1,000 is Regine Swanson, a senior at Florida A & M University studying Architecture. Each academic year FEFPA offers cash scholarship awards of \$3,000, \$2,000 and \$1,000 to deserving Florida college students, distributed half in the Fall and half in the Spring semester. 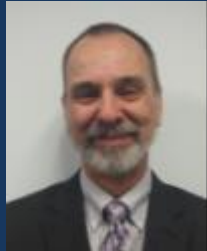
