On behalf of the FEFPA Board of Directors, we want to thank you for your continued support and participation in FEFPA. Despite the many challenges we faced over the past 18 months, our Sponsors and Educational Members remained focused and committed, while accepting the reality of flexible planning. Thank you to all for your understanding and resilience. A special thank you to past President David Wildes and the Board for a successful FEFPA 2021 Summer Conference at the Diplomat Resort in Hollywood Florida.

Some Highlights of the Summer 2021 Conference are as follows:

- A total of 516 attendees; the 2nd highest attendee count in the last 10 years.
- A total of 20 first-time Educational Member attendees.
- A total of 12 new Sponsors.
- 100% capacity in the exhibit hall/exhibit spill-out area.
- A Conference Agenda offering 26 Educational Sessions, including a Keynote Speaker.
- First-time Educational Members lunch and orientation.

FEFPA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

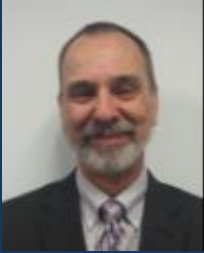
