Legislative Update



- School Hardening
 - General Appropriations, \$50,000,000
 - Amendment proposing an additional \$25,000,000



SB 70 Panic Alarms

 Require at least one panic alarm per public school building to be directly linked to the local law enforcement agency that is the first responder for emergencies including, but not limited to, a non-fire evacuation, lockdown, or active shooter situation. Said panic alarm must send an immediate signal to authorities upon activation.



SB 834 Emergency Alerts

 Authorizing a local law enforcement agency to activate the emergency alert system and issue a Lockdown Alert to public and private schools and child care facilities under certain circumstances



SB 168 Prevention of lead in Drinking Water

- Requires water filter be installed at each district school built before 1986.
- "Point of Use" be installed at all water sources for drinking, food prep or cooking.
- Certified filter capacity of 7,900 gallons.
- Post conspicuous signage at all non drinking water sources.
- Maintain website with a list of drinking water sources at each school with specific information.



SB 1190 Cooling Tower Registration and Maintenance

 Requires owners to register cooling towers with the Department of Health.



SB 632 Education

- Require charter schools to comply with the State Requirements for Educational Facilities of the Florida Building Code.
- Require private schools to comply with the State Requirements for Educational Facilities of the Florida Building Code.
- Establishes an effective date of July 1, 2020.



SB 934 First Aid for Severe Bleeding

- Require each district school board to provide at least one bleeding control kit in every school within the school district.
- Require each school district to provide instruction for all students in first aid for severe bleeding.
- Require students to study and practice first aid skills for severe bleeding at least once before graduating from high school.



HB 603 Carbon Monoxide Alarms

- Require each K-12 traditional public school facility that has a feature, fixture, or element that emits carbon monoxide as a byproduct of combustion to install a carbon monoxide alarm.
- Require each carbon monoxide alarm to be connected to the fire alarm system



HB 669 Universal Changing Places

 Requires certain entities to install & maintain at least one universal changing place at specified locations; specifies requirements for universal changing place



HB 7011 K-12 Student Athletes

 Require each public school that is a member of the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) to have an automated external defibrillator (AED) available in a clearly marked location for any athletic contest, practice, workout or conditioning session, including those that occur outside of the school year.
