#### **ARCHITECTURAL SHOWCASE**

The 2024 FEFPA Winter Conference Architectural Showcase once again proved to be an exhibition of outstanding creativity and innovation in school facility design. The projects submitted this year were representative of all corners of the state. The solutions were very exciting and continue to illustrate the high level of design in the educational environment while integrating sustainable solutions. These outstanding projects will contribute to their institution's academic success and inspire our educational members to raise their design standards for future facilities.


