


## THIRTY-SIXTH ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

## FEFPA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2025 -2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

Congratulations to this year's FEFPA Scholarship winners!

Thanks to our generous sponsors and proceeds from the 36<sup>th</sup> annual golf tournament this year we will award scholarships to four deserving students in Florida colleges and universities. The top ranked scholarship winner who was awarded \$3,000 is Dat Phan, a graduate student at the University of South Florida studying Architecture; the second ranked scholarship winner who will receive \$2,500 is Jamie Meeks, a graduate student at Florida State University studying Urban & Regional Planning; the third ranked scholarship winner who will receive \$2,000 is Rosemary Wagner, a graduate student at Florida State University studying Interior Architecture; and the fourth ranked scholarship winner who will receive \$1,500 is Harrison Lee, a Junior at Florida International University studying Architecture. We look forward to hearing more about them at our Winter Conference during the first week of February 2026.

Each academic year FEFPA offers cash scholarship awards of \$3,000, \$2,500, \$2,000 and \$1,500 to deserving Florida college students, distributed half in the Fall and half in the Spring semester. Eligible applicants include sophomore through upper-level undergraduate and graduate students who meet the eligibility requirements stated on the application instructions.
