



# FISH Certification of Facilities Data

Prior to April 1 of each year, each district shall review FISH (Florida Inventory of School Houses) and shall certify to the Office of Educational Facilities that the inventory is current and accurate, using the Certification of Facilities Data.

# Florida Statutes Chapter 1013

## Functions of the Department and the Board of Governors

(3) Require boards to submit other educational plant inventories data and statistical data or information relevant to construction, capital improvements, and related costs.

(d) Periodic update of Florida Inventory of School Houses.—School districts shall periodically update their inventory of educational facilities as new capacity becomes available and as unsatisfactory space is eliminated. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to determine the timeframe in which districts must provide a periodic update.

## SREF Chapter 6.1(5)(c): Facilities Inventory Data

- Prior to April 1 of each year, each district shall review FISH and shall certify to the Office that the inventory is current and accurate, using the Certification of Facilities Data (OEF Form FISH-Cert)

- When a contract has been signed to add new buildings
- When physically remodeling and changing use of space
- When you have a FLDOE approved Castaldi to raze a building\*
- When you have added or removed relocatables
- When school grade configuration has changed\*
- Selling property\*
- After FISH validation study

\*Educational plant survey required

# School Closure – Consolidation – Grade Configuration

- Need to be in consultation with the Office of Educational Facilities
  - Must have a survey recommendation
  - Must assign students to other facilities with available capacity within the survey.

## Assigning MSIDs and Various Scenarios

- Must have an educational plant survey if moving to an ancillary facility
- May need a new MSID – Cannot have one MSID at two facilities
- Must update the MSID address with the MSID office
- Rooms must be capacity carrying spaces (to assign a classroom)
- Must notify the MSID Office when closing a school

- Requires an Educational Plant Survey

## Article XII Section 9 of the Florida Constitution

- ...and which capital outlay projects have been approved by the school board of the school district or board of trustees of the community college district, pursuant to the most recent survey or surveys conducted under regulations prescribed by the state board to determine the capital outlay needs of the school district or community college district.
- ... on the basis of a survey made pursuant to regulations of the state board and approved by the state board, all such funds remaining shall be distributed annually and used for such school purposes in such school district...
- ...only in the order of priority of needs, as shown by a survey or surveys conducted in the school district ...
