ARCHITECTURAL SHOWCASE

The 2026 FEPA Winter Conference Architectural Showcase once again showed amazing creativity and innovative ideas in educational facility design. The projects submitted this year were diverse and show exceptional quality across the state. The solutions were exciting and continue to illustrate the complexity of design in the educational environment while integrating sustainable solutions.
